The 63<sup>rd</sup> annual Ohio University High School Journalism Workshop is July 31-August 2, 2008.

The first evening begins with a welcome and small group critique sessions focused on the student's own newspaper and broadcast programs.

The workshop is open to any student who wishes to improve his/her journalism skills or who will serve in an editor's position (e.g., editor-in-chief, managing editor, feature editor, sports editor) on his/her school paper for the 2008-2009 school year.

**Enrollment is limited to 60 and is on a first-come basis.**

Advisers are encouraged to attend and participate in the same classes the students will attend.

Students will live in a university residence hall and eat in a dining hall. All classes will be held in the state-of-the-art facilities at E.W. Scripps Hall. Students have a strictly enforced 11 p.m. curfew. Room, board and workshop fee is \$300. Advisers may arrange room and board on campus or plan their own accommodations. Confirmation will be sent upon receipt of completed registration form. Each participant will also receive a packet containing registration information and a campus map. **Full refunds will be made for cancellations made prior to July 2. Only the room and board portion of the fee will be refunded after July 2.**

The Ohio University High School Journalism Workshop is unique in that a select group of serious high school journalists is given the opportunity to work closely with outstanding journalism educators and professionals.

## Certificate and Adviser College Credit

All students who complete the program will receive a certificate of participation from the E.W. Scripps School of Journalism.

All advisers who complete the program will receive a certificate of participation and may earn one quarter hour of undergraduate or graduate credit by completing the workshop and up to three additional hours by completing the workshop and developing a formal project to be completed later in the summer.

The deadline for turning in a completed project is September 15, 2008.

Cost for **each** credit hour for advisers is \$283 in-state and \$578 out-of-state per undergraduate hour and \$387 in-state and \$718 out-of-state per graduate hour.

**Tuition for this program is not covered by the summer quarter comprehensive fee.**
