Every summer, the school offers high school students and teachers the opportunity to interact with our faculty while learning the latest techniques for doing journalism in a school setting. Mark your calendar to attend the 2018 High School Journalism Workshop!

The workshop will include professionals as well as faculty from the **School of Journalism** and the **School of Visual Communication**, two of the premier institutions in the nation.

Ohio University's High School Journalism Workshop will include:

- Opportunities to experience the latest journalism techniques
- Diversity scholarships that cover up to 100 percent of the cost of the workshop for students from diverse backgrounds and experiences*
- An opportunity to spend time on Ohio University's historic Athens campus
- And the chance to **earn a college credit!**

Tracks include: Broadcast Journalism, Magazine, Mobile/Online, News, Photojournalism.

Returning this year! – Advertising and Public Relations and Publication Design. Advertising and Public Relations sessions taught by our award-winning and nationally recognized faculty. Students will be taught how to unleash their creativity in print, online, broadcast and social media. Design sessions will focus on publication design.



High school students will:

- Develop and sharpen skills in one of seven specialized tracks.
- Attend general session presentations by noted journalism professionals, as well as take part in discussions on journalism trends, legal issues, and careers.
- Receive feedback from award-winning faculty and professional journalists on their scholastic publications and productions.
- Earn one hour of college credit (eligible students must be juniors or seniors, have at least a B average, and complete an additional application form).
- Develop contacts and friendships that last a lifetime!

Advisers will:

- Attend sessions specially designed for high school journalism advisers.
- Observe their students during select sessions.
- Take part in the general sessions.

NOTE: Advisers can apply to co-teach track sessions, which will reduce the cost of attendance.

Workshop Fee. The workshop fee of \$300 covers room and board for the program as well as sessions and all materials. Discounted rates are available for students and advisers who commute. There are no additional university fees for the optional one hour of credit. Diversity scholarships are available to students through support from the Scripps Howard Foundation.

General Workshop Information:

Students will stay in a campus dormitory, eat in university dining facilities, and interact with faculty, graduate students, media professionals, and current undergraduate students. The dorms and all activities are supervised.

Workshop and dorm check-in will be noon-2:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 11*, with the opening assembly scheduled for 2:30 p.m. that day. Workshop sessions and converged newsroom activities run until about 10 p.m. each night. The workshop ends Saturday following a closing assembly. Dorm check-out is at 2 p.m.

*For those traveling long distances, dorm rooms are available Tuesday evening for an additional fee of \$30. Check-in time for early arrivers is 6-8:00 p.m. on July 10. Those who will be flying in are encouraged to arrive on Tuesday because of travel time from the airport.
